4. General Description of the Position	The Junior Coaching Coordinator has oversight responsibility for all junior grades from Under 8 through to Under 16. The position is support role for all appointed junior coaches at Flinders Park

Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To coordinate, educate and evaluate all coaches at training and on match days • To link junior and senior aspects of the club through joint coach education sessions • Assist with the development of all coaches • Provide ideas and advice on training drills and skills where appropriate • Offer assistance for training skills and drills • Coordinate education nights etc for coaches and team age groups as required • Recommend new equipment purchases where required to the Junior Football Committee • Liaise with all coaches, providing feedback on training and match day observations • Provide input and advice on all football related policies including team selection and squad management
6. Successful Outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% accreditation of junior coaches. Level 1 or above • Junior coaches feel supported and have the opportunity to develop their skills • Minimum of 2 coach education seminars held each year • Set up team plan/style of play for competition known from under 11 and above • Nominate players for all junior development (SANFL) squads
